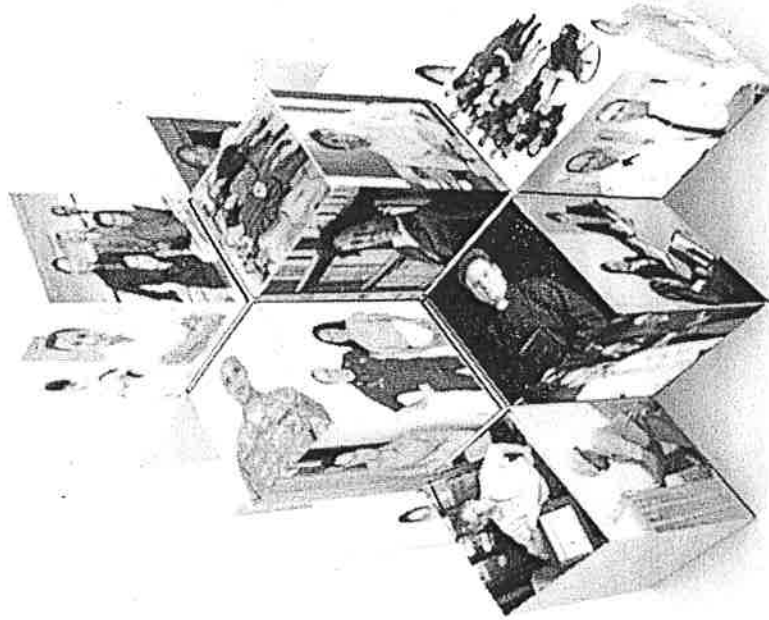

We have many facilities located throughout the nation: 121 Institutions, 26 Residential Reentry Management Offices, 6 Regional Offices, 2 Staff Training Academies, and Headquarters.

GENERAL ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

- U.S. citizenship is required
- Initial appointments of employees into Federal Bureau of Prisons' law enforcement positions **must** be prior to your 37th birthday (some exceptions apply, i.e., Medical Officers, Physician Assistants, Nurse Practitioners, Register Nurses, Chaplains (Catholic, Islamic and Jewish), and Psychologists may be appointed up to age 40)
- Qualified Preference Eligible Veterans may be exempt from meeting the maximum entry age of 37
- Males born after 12/31/59 must be registered for or exempt from the selective service
- Successful completion of an applicant Core Value Assessment (CVA)
- Medical and Physical Examination
- Drug Testing
- Background investigation
- Successful completion of Correctional Techniques Training to include successful completion of a Physical Abilities Test (PAT)
