Qualifications:

Must have experience working with children in an instructional and/or supervisory capacity, preferably in a school setting.

NCLB Compliance (Two years of college (48 units), or AA degree (or higher), or Pass a local assessment of knowledge and skills in assisting in instruction)

Proof of HS Graduation (High school diploma, high school transcripts or the equivalent)

Abilities:

Work and deal effectively with people of all socio-economic and cultural backgrounds; Ability to plan, organize, and set up daily activities, special events, field trips, and/or other related events as assigned.
