- EAP score of "Exempt" or "Ready" for college-level Math courses.
- EAP score of "Conditionally ready" or "Conditional" for college-level Math courses **AND** the California Standards Test in Summative High School Mathematics or Algebra II, provided successful completion of a CSU approved 12th grade math course that require Algebra II as a prerequisite.
- High school 11th or 12th grade cumulative GPA of 3.0 or better (within the last 10 years).
- *High school 11th or 12th grade cumulative GPA of 3.3 or better Math 138 or 161 ONLY (within the last 7 years).
- SAT score of 550 or above in Mathematics or Reasoning (test dates prior to March 2016).
- SAT score of 570 or above on the Math Section (test dates after March 2016).
- Score of 23 or above on ACT Mathematics Test (within the last 5 years).
- CLEP score of 50 or above on College Algebra.
- ELM score of 50 or higher (within the last 5 years).
- Score of 3 or above on the Calculus AB, Calculus BC, or Statistics AP Exams.

Please note: If you received a score of 4 or above on either Calculus AB or BC AP Exams, you are eligible to enroll in MATH 172; additionally, if you received a score of 5 on Calculus BC AP exam you are eligible to enroll in MATH 173 and do not need to complete this form.
