

## **Release of Student Information**

Submit completed form in-person to Enrollment Services with photo identification.

The Family Educational Rights & Privacy Act (FERPA) regulates the disclosure of educational information. FERPA states "when a student becomes an eligible student (18 years of age or is attending an institution of postsecondary education), the rights accorded to parents transfer from the parents to the student".

As an institution, Modesto Junior College does not collect daily attendance records from each instructor. Attendance records may be kept by some instructors for grading purposes, but that information is not readily available to counselors or Enrollment Services staff.

The Release of Student Information Form must be submitted with proper identification of both the student and parent/guardian in which information is being released to.
