

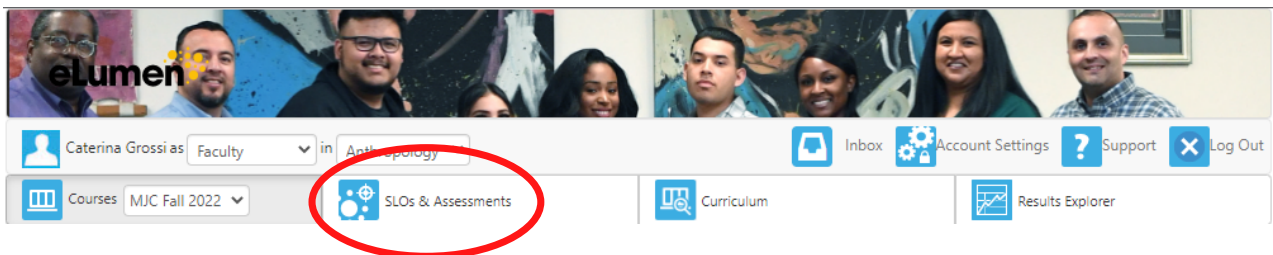
# Finding CLOs in eLumen

1. Access the eLumen page and sign through single sign-on

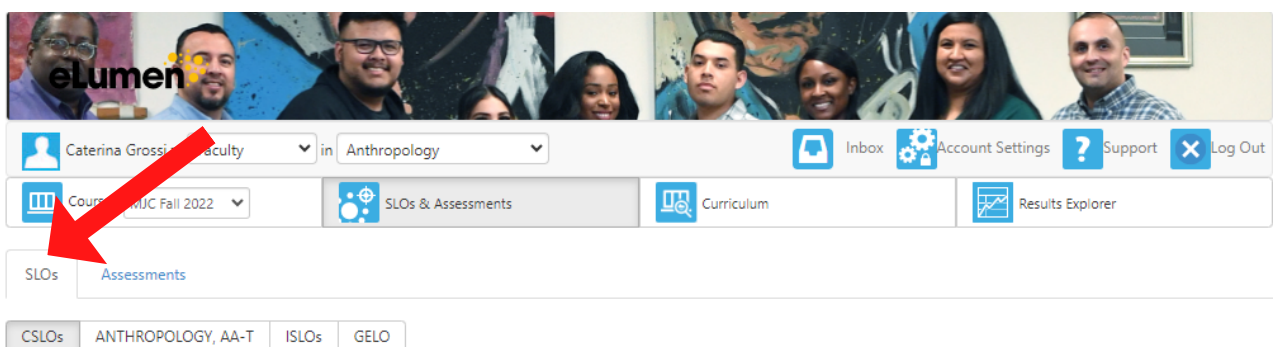
