

Community College Academic Partnership and Scholarship Program

Brandman University offers educational programs regionally accredited by WASC Senior College and University Commission (WSCUC) and has established a Brandman University Scholarship Program designed to support organizations with their employee and student development efforts. **Modesto Junior College** wishes to participate in the scholarships available through this program as part of its employee and student benefits.

The Parties acknowledge the following:

1. University will offer and fund Brandman University Scholarships to **Modesto Junior College** employees and employees' spouses and dependents, for new student enrollments as further defined below. Other scholarships, military funding and discounts may not be combined. Enrollment data will be evaluated and reported to College bi-annually.
 - **Undergraduate hybrid and traditional online programs:** Scholarship of ten percent of undergraduate tuition rate
 - **Undergraduate MyPath programs:** Scholarship of ten percent of MyPath program tuition rate
 - **Master's degree programs:** Scholarship of ten percent of master's degree tuition rate
 - **Master of Arts in Educational Leadership and Administration, Master of Arts in Teaching, and Teaching Credentials program:** scholarship of twenty percent of tuition rate
 - **Ed.D. Organizational Leadership program:** Scholarship of ten percent of tuition rate
 - **RN to BSN program:** Scholarship of fifteen percent of tuition rate
 - **Organization Custom Off-site Cohorts:** Scholarship of twenty percent tuition (as approved by University).
 - **School of Extended Education open enrollment leadership and business courses:** Scholarship of ten percent of cost of program. Many programs are already discounted. Discounts cannot be combined.
2. College students who complete a **Modesto Junior College** Associate Degree for Transfer (AA-T or AS-T) or Associate Degree (AA or AS) with a CSU-GE or IGETC are guaranteed admission to Brandman. **Modesto Junior College** students who have a minimum of 12 credits with a minimum 2.0 cumulative Grade Point Average (GPA) in all prior transferable college-level coursework from regionally accredited post-secondary institutions are also eligible for guaranteed admission to Brandman.

Students may declare their intent to attend Brandman and be admitted under the TAG to receive the scholarships listed in section 3, at any time while they are enrolled at **Modesto Junior College** by simply completing Brandman's Application for Admission and selecting the Community College TAG option on the application. To ensure timely degree completion, students are encouraged to gain admission to Brandman as soon as they are eligible.

The TAG works in conjunction with Brandman transfer pathway guides to ensure student coursework is easily transferred from College to University. College Student Education Plans (SEP) aligned with Brandman transfer pathway guides will assist College students and counselors

by identifying how previous coursework may be applied to Brandman's general education, program-specific, and/or general elective degree requirements. Students who have completed one of the following five degrees and/or certificates from **Modesto Junior College** or other California community colleges will be credited with fulfilling Brandman's general education basic and breadth requirements:

- a. Associate Degree for Transfer (AA-T or AS-T);
 - b. California State University General Education Breadth (CSU-GE);
 - c. Intersegmental General Education Transfer Curriculum (IGETC); or
 - d. **Modesto Junior College** Associate Degree (AA or AS) with a CSU-GE or IGETC.
 - e. **Modesto Junior College** Associate Degree (AA or AS) with a native general education pattern will be reviewed on a case-by-case basis.
3. If the above requirements are met, University will offer and fund Brandman University Scholarships to **Modesto Junior College** students, for new student enrollments as further defined below. Other scholarships, military funding and discounts may not be combined.
- **Undergraduate hybrid and traditional online programs:** Scholarship of ten percent of undergraduate tuition rate
 - **Undergraduate MyPath programs:** Scholarship of ten percent of MyPath program tuition rate
 - **RN to BSN program:** Scholarship of fifteen percent of tuition rate
 - **School of Extended Education open enrollment leadership and business courses:** Scholarship of ten percent of cost of program. Many programs are already discounted. Discounts cannot be combined.
4. The scholarship percentage offered will remain fixed for the duration of the entire academic program so long as the student does not miss more than two consecutive sessions, continues to make satisfactory academic progress, and remains in good academic and financial standing in accordance with University's existing catalog. University's tuition rates are subject to change. Students must fill out a scholarship application form and submit the same to Admissions. All College employees, employees' spouses and dependents, and students currently enrolled with University, must acknowledge the scholarship opportunity within the session immediately following the Brandman University Scholarship Program start date. There is no discount on textbooks or fees associated with any University program.
