UPDATE ONLINE
REGISTRATION INFORMATION**

- Proposed by:** Jim Sahlman
- WHEREAS,** MJC students can register for classes by reviewing a printed course schedule as well as by viewing available courses online, and
- WHEREAS,** The printed schedule provides some information that is unavailable in the online format (e.g., special instructions for online classes, lab material fees, classroom software to be used, student-furnished equipment requirements, etc.), and
- WHEREAS,** The current prerequisite information online is inconsistent with the prerequisite information provided in the printed class schedules, and
- WHEREAS,** Consistency between the printed and online formats would help students become more informed when choosing their class schedules, as well as assist the faculty in informing potential students about special issues pertinent to specific classes;
- THEREFORE,** **BE IT RESOLVED** that the Academic Senate recommends that special announcements and prerequisites reflect the same information for both the printed and online formats of the class schedule.
