**Student Learning Outcomes (SLO) Facilitator Position**

- Proposed by:** MJC Academic Senate SLO Committee – Michael Sundquist, Chair
- Whereas:** The development of measurable student learning outcomes is important to the improvement of teaching and learning at Modesto Junior College, and
- Whereas:** The development of measurable student learning outcomes at the course, program and college levels is an important focus of the new accreditation standards, and
- Whereas:** It is the responsibility of the faculty to design and implement changes to courses and programs, and
- Whereas:** It is necessary to lead and support faculty efforts to develop measurable student learning outcomes with training resources; coordination of mentors; analysis of assessment results and other related activities,
- Therefore:** **Be it resolved** that the Academic Senate support the establishment of a SLO Facilitator beginning no later than the Fall 2005 semester and that the Senate’s SLO Committee be charged with developing a job description and screening applicants for said position.
- Therefore:** **Be it further resolved** that this SLO Facilitator position have adequate support staff time, budget and office space in order to program associated activities.
- Therefore:** **Be it further resolved** that the SLO Facilitator shall chair the Senate SLO Committee and coordinate activities with the Academic Senate President.
