Tracking Accreditation Expenditures

Proposed by: MJC Academic Senate Executive Board

Whereas: “Faculty roles and involvement in accreditation process” as well as “institutional planning and budget development” are academic and professional matters (YCCD Board Policy 4103 and Title 5 § 53200)

Whereas: The Accreditation and Institutional Effectiveness and the Planning Budget Committees are responsible for ensuring that the processes and expenses are tracked, documented, and followed; and;

Whereas: Modesto Junior College is currently on probation with the Accrediting Commission for Community and Junior Colleges (ACCJC)

Resolved: That the MJC Academic Senate and the YCCD Board of Trustees and/or its designees consult collegially about: 91) the accreditation process; and (2) how accreditation expenditures are reflected in the budget process (i.e., stipends, consultant fees, release time, software, travel, duplicating, etc.); and

Resolved: That the MJC Academic Senate recommends that these discussions be used to evaluate the contributions of these processes and expenditures in order to promote effective use of financial resources and faculty involvement in the accreditation process.”
