RESOLUTION FL98-K: DIVISION CURRICULUM COMMITTEES

WHEREAS, Not all members of the Curriculum Committee are qualified to evaluate the content and curricular integrity of rigorous academic preparation in disciplines other than their own, and

WHEREAS, The committee is an advising body to the President of the College, and

WHEREAS, College Policy (310.005) clearly states that the divisions may establish their own committees, "the intent of which is to study on behalf of its organization areas under consideration by the standing committees of the college";

THEREFORE, **BE IT RESOLVED** that each division of the college appoint its own Division Curriculum Committee, empowered to make course recommendations to the College President, and

THEREFORE, Committee have as its sole function that of determining graduation requirements and the selection of courses to fulfill specific requirements.
