WHEREAS, the goal of the job faires is to increase candidate pools for faculty and administrative vacancies in terms of size and diversity, and

WHEREAS, size and diversity of candidate pools for faculty and administrative vacancies have not increased significantly to date, and

WHEREAS, some districts have approached candidates in a more intense and personal fashion and have achieved significant success in using this approach;

THEREFORE, **BE IT RESOLVED** that a team of faculty and administrators will host a meeting of candidates at both the January 29th and February 5th job faires and encourage all candidates to apply in recognition of the diversity sought by the Yosemite Community College District. Equal treatment of all candidates will be assured.
