

**MJC ACADEMIC SENATE**  
**Resolution SP03-E: Oversight Committee for the**  
**MIS Implementation Process**

- Proposed By:** Executive Board
- Whereas:** is essential for the District to meet its academic needs (Instruction and Student Services) for at least the next decade, and
- Whereas:** YCCD has invested over \$6 million in the hardware and software and a consulting company, CampusWorks, to assist in its implementation, and
- Whereas:** CampusWorks has assumed a management rather than a consulting role within information systems at the District and colleges and this position of power has served to weaken the comfort and resolve of information system personnel to offer their insight into how this new MIS system can best be integrated within the District and college uses.
- Whereas:** A free and open exchange of ideas and good training is essential to the success of this process, it is essential that IS personnel can collegially engage in this process;
- Therefore:** **Be It Resolved** that the Academic Senate of Modesto Junior College, in cooperation with the Columbia College Faculty Senate and the Yosemite Faculty Association will create the YCCD Faculty Oversight Committee to District IS issues. The committee will meet with representatives from the Senate Committee for the Implementation of the Administrative/Educational Software, College and District IS personnel, CampusWorks representatives, Columbia College Senate and the YFA to freely discuss concerns. The committee should expeditiously forward to the full Senates and YFA any concerns that they feel need to be addressed.

- Final Action:** April 17, 2003
- Proposed Disposition:** The Senate feels that the needs of Resolution SP03-E have been met by the YCCD Technology Coordination Committee with the following action:
