- Proposed by:** Senate Committee on the Implementation of Administrative/Education Software
- Whereas:** the Yosemite Community College District (YCCD), Modesto Junior College (MJC), and Columbia College (CC) are involved in the implementation of a highly-integrated administrative computer system; and
