Anthropology/Geography, the Measure E Committee  
and the Program Management Plan**

- Whereas:** During the Measure E process a proposal has repeatedly resurfaced to remove Geography and Anthropology from the Business, Behavioral and Social Sciences Division (BBSS) and move the programs to the proposed Science Community Center within the Science, Math and Engineering (SME) Division.
- Whereas:** This proposal DID NOT originate from either SME or BBSS, and does not have the support of either.
- Whereas:** Neither the Founders Hall nor the Science Community Center Project Committees presentations to the Measure E Committee suggested that the programs be moved.
- Whereas:** On November 4<sup>th</sup>, 2005 the Measure E Committee acknowledged that this proposal to move Anthropology and Geography was a mistake, and Kitchell was directed to remove it from their plans.
- Whereas:** Despite multiple requests since that meeting, the draft of the Program Management Plan published by Kitchell on January 9, 2006 states “Move Anthropology/Geography to Science Community Center” (p. 56) as a major goal.
- Therefore:** **Be it resolved**, that all reference to the removal of Anthropology and Geography from BBSS be deleted from all Measure E related materials – especially the Program Management Plan and any other document that could be construed as allowing such a process to continue.
- First Reading:** Approved January 19, 2006.
- Second Reading:** Rules suspended, resolution unanimously approved January 19, 2006.
- Disposition:** Language changes/deletions will be submitted in writing to the Measure E Committee. Kitchell will correct the Project Management Plan (PMP) and the District will correct the YCCD Facilities Master Plan (FMP).
