

**MJC ACADEMIC SENATE
RESOLUTION SP99-E:
TEAM FUNDING
APRIL 1, 1999**

- Proposed by:** Steve DaPrato, Cheryl Mulder, and MJC Academic Senate Executive Board
- WHEREAS:** Modesto Junior College faculty have the best interests of their students in mind, and
- WHEREAS:** current funding is inadequate for the physical education team programs at Modesto Junior College, and
- WHEREAS:** faculty are expected to deliver programs of excellence, and
- WHEREAS:** the educational commitment is to the faculty spending their time placing students in institutions of higher learning and facilitating their success at Modesto Junior College, and
- WHEREAS:** some programs require team participation, and
- WHEREAS:** teams are expected to participate in a manner that is representative of the league, and
- WHEREAS:** teams are required to be in uniform in a manner that is consistent with league regulations, and
- WHEREAS:** teams are expected to travel great distances to participate in league competitions, and
- WHEREAS:** coaches at Modesto Junior College are currently expected to supplement funds for their programs to make a competitive team that is comparable to other teams in the league;
- THEREFORE:** **BE IT RESOLVED** that the MJC Academic Senate requests that the college and YCCD adequately fund and support our athletic team programs to provide reasonable and predictable financial and staff support for these programs and activities.
- First Reading:** April 22, 1999
- Final Action:** Approved May 6, 1999
- Disposition:** Forwarded to College President and YCCD Chancellor. Although no Additional general fund revenue have been allocated to teams, additional MJC Foundation money has been used to support teams. No college teams have been eliminated.
