Adoption of Program Viability, Revitalization, and Discontinuance Procedures

Modesto Junior College Academic Senate

Proposed by Academic Senate Executive Committee

- WHEREAS, In accordance with Education Code §78016, Title 5 §51022 and §55130, and ACCJC Accreditation Standard II.A.15, colleges must develop a policy and a process for program evaluation and discontinuance;
- WHEREAS, YCCD Board Policy 4021, “Program Discontinuance” stipulates that the Chancellor “shall ensure the District complies with applicable laws and mandates for program discontinuance;”
- WHEREAS, YCCD Board Policy 4021 does not currently include a procedure for program evaluation and discontinuance;
- WHEREAS, the Academic Senate has primacy over program and curriculum development (see YCCD Policy 4020 and YCCD Policy 7-8049)
- WHEREAS, the Academic Senate envisions a discontinuance policy that includes program evaluation, viability, and revitalization in accordance with its role in program and curriculum development;
- THEREFORE, the Modesto Junior College Academic Senate adopts the attached Program Viability, Revitalization, and Discontinuance Procedures.
