RESOLUTION FL94-J: CALENDAR
OCTOBER 7, 1994

PROPOSED BY: MJC ACADEMIC SENATE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE

WHEREAS, MJC Academic Senate requests consideration of suggestion that, because the Fall Semester finals start on a Monday, a Study Day (formerly known as Dead Day) is not needed. This would result in no group or Saturday finals, and

WHEREAS, the faculty feels that the Presidential holidays in February would be least interruptive, and

WHEREAS, the Spring Break for this year would serve the faculty best if held the week following Easter, and

WHEREAS, we would ask the District Chancellor to hold our graduation ceremonies on Friday night rather than Thursday night, resulting in a switch with Columbia or a Chancellor designee to preside at graduation ceremony. This would result in finals starting on a Monday and there would be no need for the Study Day.

THEREFORE, be it resolved that the MJC Academic Senate adopt proposed calendar draft of October 7, 1994, attached to this resolution. (copy not found in minutes)

ACTION: October 13, 1994

FINAL ACTION: October 27, 1994 (approval not found in minutes of October 27, 1994)

DISPOSITION: Carried

The Resolution FL94-J was revisited on November 17, 1994. The calendar passed by the Senate was not accepted by the President's Advisory Team and Student Services Council. After a short discussion the following took place:

M/S that the Senate has reconsidered the calendar issue, and reaffirms the previous recommendation made in Resolution FL94-J. Motion carried with a unanimous vote.
