WHEREAS, the only change is to add the words "sexual orientation." and

WHEREAS, this policy wording and the lengthy procedures were reviewed extensively five years ago by all constituencies and by legal counsel,

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the MJC Academic Senate recommend the adoption of the PROPOSED REVISION TO YCCD POLICIES #4017 AND #5027.

In the December 1, 1994 minutes, in Continuing business: Resolution FL94-L: ASMJC Proposed Revision to YCCD Policies #4017 and #5027 adding Sexual Orientation to Discrimination Policy. It states "following discussion, it was M/S to accept Resolution FL94-L, Motion passed with two abstentions." It is unknown what if any revisions were approved. There is no copy available. This is the copy from the November 17, 1994 meeting.

This resolution is FL94-N: with the title "Proposed Revision to YCCD Policies #4017 and #5027. " Officially it does not show as being approved. FL94-L shows approved, unless it was switched and FL94-L was not approved and FL94-N was. On the original documents in the Resolutions Binder each one shows approved on December 1, 1994.
