WHEREAS, The Academic Senate is the principal faculty organization that oversees academic issues, and

WHEREAS, significant expansion in class size may introduce qualitative as well as quantitative difference in the delivery of instruction,

WHEREAS, existing course outlines are not written with large classes in mind and in some course, course methodology may require modifications when implemented in large class sessions to assure course objectives are met.

WHEREAS, additional support staffing requirements of large classes should be formally recognized,

THEREFORE, be it resolved that any proposal to tech an augmented course (doubling or tripling of the class size) be reviewed by the MJC Curriculum Committee to determine that the design of the course is adequate to meet its objectives.
