RESOLUTION FL95-G: PETITION TO AMEND BY-LAWS AND RULES
NOVEMBER 13, 1995

Proposed by: Academic Senate Executive Committee

WHEREAS, the current By-Laws and Rules of the MJC Academic Senate contain provisions that are inconsistent, ambiguous, and/or in conflict with past practice with regard to nomination procedures, and

THEREFORE, be it resolved that the By-Laws be changed in the following manner:

IV.3.A. The nomination for the President shall take place at the first ~~regularly~~ regularly scheduled general session in November of the Modesto Junior College Academic Senate or at any subsequent regularly scheduled general session until such time as nominations are closed.

D. The name of any Faculty Member may be placed in nomination for the office of President.

THEREFORE, be it further resolved that the Rules be changed in the following manner.

I.B. The president shall appoint annually a Nominating and Election Committee and chair in October.

C. Nominations. With the consent of the nominee, can be delivered in writing to the chair of the Nominating Committee ~~before the December meeting.~~ Nominations may be made by the Nominating Committee, or they can originate from the floor ~~during the December meeting.~~ For officers other than the President all nominees shall be Senators at the time of their nominations.

Delete Section VI.F.3. describing the Nominating Committee as a Standing Committee of the Senate.

Be it moved that IV.3.D be replaced by:
