RESOLUTION FL97-L: FACULTY INVOLVEMENT IN FACILITIES PLANNING**

Proposed by: Academic Senate for California Community Colleges

WHEREAS, facilities development and campus construction have direct effects on educational programs and campus climates and should evolve from an educational master plan, and

WHEREAS, district and college facilities master plans are not uniformly formulated, and

WHEREAS, effective planning includes academic senates and faculty members;

THEREFORE, be it resolved that Modesto Junior College Academic Senate seek a weighted voice in the development of any college and/or district educational master plan from which facilities and construction master plans evolve, and

THEREFORE, be it further resolved that the Modesto Junior College Academic Senate debate and approved college and/or district current and future educational, facilities, and construction master plans that pertain to all college

THEREFORE, be it further resolved that, if district or college administrators or boards ignore this resolution, the Modesto Junior College Academic Senate, submit minority reports to the Chancellor's Office and also submit a similar report to the college accreditation self-study and visiting team.
