RESOLUTION SP96-S: MJC FACULTY PARTICIPATION IN DISTRICT SHARED GOVERNANCE  
APRIL 22, 1996**

- PROPOSED BY:** Allen Boyer, President
- WHEREAS,** for this semester, Spring 1996, the Modesto Junior College Academic Senate has boycotted all Yosemite Community College District meetings, and
- WHEREAS,** this boycott was a result of a dispute over Shared Governance and Access to the Board of Trustees decision-making process, and
- WHEREAS,** the faculty leadership team has met with the Board of Trustees sub-committee and the Chancellor a number of times, and
- WHEREAS,** these meetings have resulted in favorable consensus on the following issues: (1) the Presidential replacement at Columbia College; (2) the planning for a number of open form strategic seminars with the Board of Trustees on current issues; (3) a planned June retreat to restructure and refocus the District Council; (4) an adherence to Side Letter 6 in the Yosemite Faculty Association contract which is a Yosemite Community College District policy and procedure for the evaluations of educational administrators; (5) a new trial policy and procedure for the evaluation of the chancellor that includes faculty input (surveys and representation on evaluation team); (6) and finally, the resolution of establishing either a resource position or a faculty consultant position to the Yosemite Community College District Board of Trustees by June 4, 1996;
- THEREFORE,** be it resolved that the Modesto Junior College Academic Senate rescind its boycott of all Yosemite Community College District councils and committees and participate fully in all Yosemite Community College District Shared Governance as of May 15, 1996.
