Previously an “M” was used as a Course-ID for Modesto Junior College courses. The new courses are set up without the “M.” Work is in progress to remedy this. Courses with one section have been moved into the new Course-IDs and assessments distributed. Courses with multiple sections will be moved by eLumen’s IT department, after which assessments will be distributed.

It was noted that the real assessment takes place within the classroom, it is just data that is input into eLumen.
