Accessing Degree Plan Through Starfish

- In a new tab, go to the MJC website and click on the blue star in the upper right hand corner labeled **Starfish**.
- If you are not automatically logged in, please log in again.
- Once logged in click on the three lines in the upper left hand corner, and select **Degree Plan**.

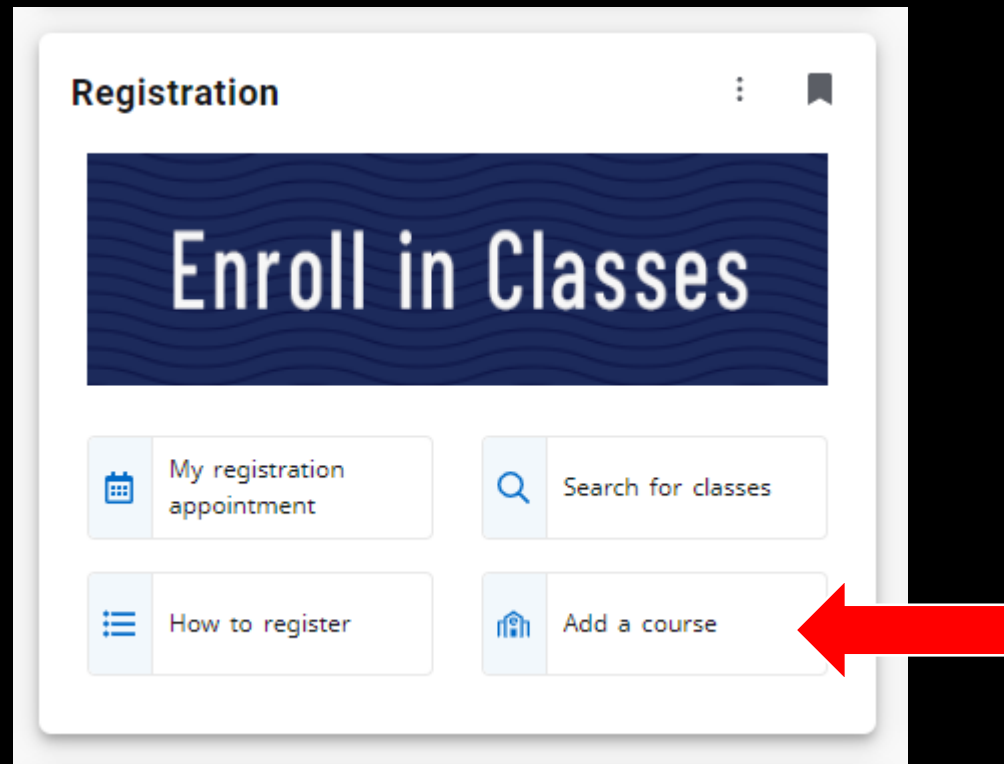


- Your Degree Plans will be listed here.

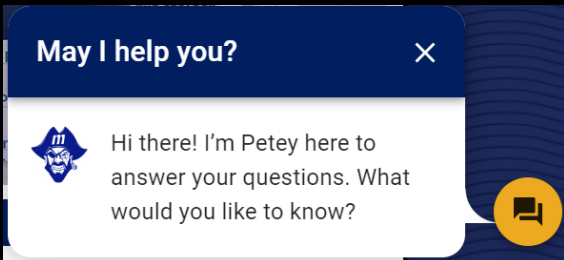
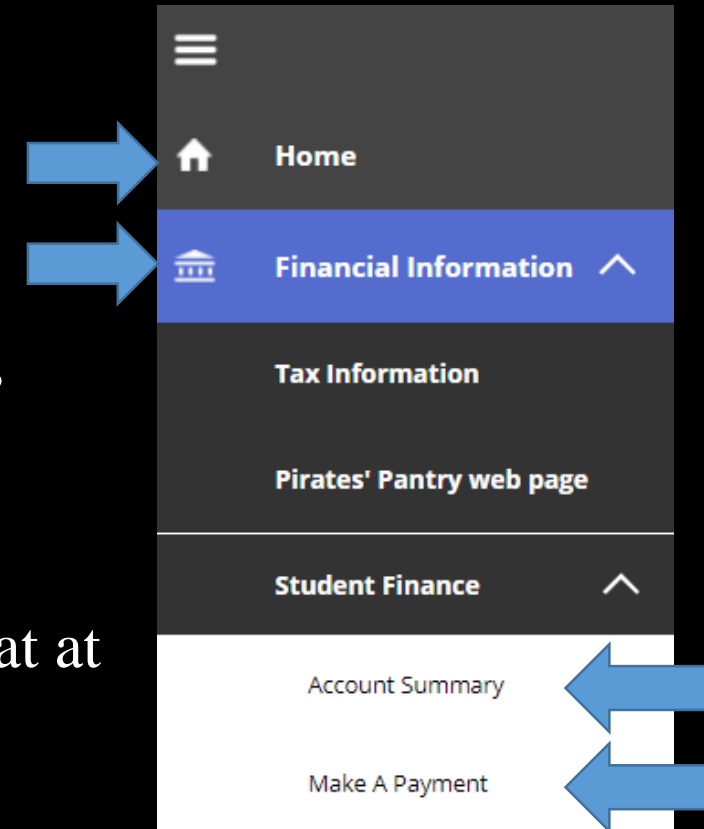

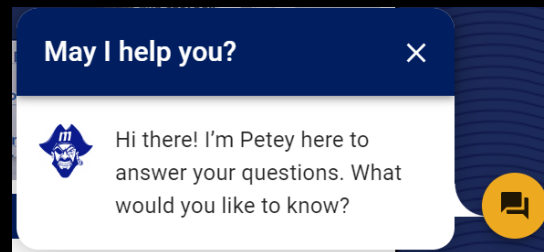
